***Divine Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom  
Byzantine Catholic Rite***

This evening we welcome Fr. Basil Malowany, the pastor at St. Athanasius Ukrainian Catholic Parish in Regina, and his wife, Angela, to the Campion Chapel.

The readings you hear today follow a different scriptural cycle from the Roman liturgical calendar, and the scriptures are proclaimed using a different translation than found in our lectionary.

**20TH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST**



In basic terms, the Ukrainian Catholic Church (also known as the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church) is a part of the Catholic Church that observes the same traditions as does Eastern Orthodoxy. It is, however, very much part of the Catholic Church. The head of the Universal Catholic Church, and all the Catholic rites, is Pope Francis.

The Ukrainian Catholic Church world-wide is governed internally by the Synod of Ukrainian Catholic Bishops; its highest ranking cleric is the Patriarch, and the regional leader is known as Eparch .

The Catholic Church consists of over twenty rites. The largest rite by population is the Roman. The non-Roman Catholic Churches fit into one of six liturgical traditions: Alexandrian, Antiochene (or Syrian), Armenian, Byzantine, Maronite, and Chaldean.

The Ukrainian Catholic Church follows the Byzantine tradition, and traces its origins to the Union of Brest in 1596 A.D., when the Church in Kyiv entered into communion with Rome.

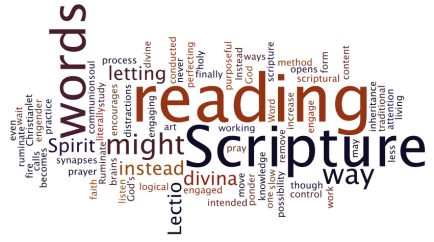
